**Universal Church Directories – Tim Norland**

- No cost to the parish.
- Parish directory, online directory, and other printed materials available.
- Can provide everything from directory printing to Christmas cards.
- The basic booklet includes 32 families, while the nicer glossy book accommodates 250 families.
- The average family typically spends around \$100.00.
- Images can include multiple generations.

**Administrator's Report & Buildings and Grounds – Father Joseph**

- The car show went very well. We had approximately 55 cars, and proceeds are expected to be around \$2,000.
- The Bandshell Mass, which was moved to HR, went very well. The insurance issue will be addressed next year through the Knights of Columbus (KOC).
- The carpet in the choir loft will be completed by July 2, 2026.
- All costs were covered through donations, the Ladies Society, and the KOC Mother's Day breakfast.
- The stairway was also repainted; however, the choir loft area was not repainted.
- Father will be on vacation from July 19 through August 5.

**Finance Committee – JoEllyn Storz**

- Conducted a comprehensive overview of the year's events, including which major expenses will be needed and which will not.
- Dominic, Father, and JoEllyn spoke with Michael Laird about the proper negotiation between the parish and the school.

**Prayer & Worship – Josh Potthast and Zachary Leonard**

- Working to audit and compile information about statues, stained-glass windows, and other items for the "Keys to Kenosha."
- They have a tenant meeting scheduled in July, if needed.
- Projects are currently on task and moving forward as planned.

**Human Concerns – Rose Giannini**

- The blood drive was very successful.
- The fan drive is ongoing and will end in July.
- The next meeting has been rescheduled.

**Stewardship Committee**

- A letter was drafted by JoEllyn.
- The committee is still working on creating a welcome package.
